

Wallpaper Installation

Easy step-by-step instructions



Step 1: Prepare the wall

1. Check that the wall is sealed and smooth and is clean, dry and free of debris
2. If the walls are old, damaged, or have flaking paint, or uneven surfaces prepare the walls with a good quality wall primer. This will aid in adhesion and make removal easier



Step 2: Spray the wall

1. Standard spray bottle can be used
2. Fill spray bottle with tap water
3. Turn nozzle spray to coarse spray function to allow high water flow
4. We recommend water to be applied at rate of 100ml per 1 square metre, starting at the top of the wall and moving downwards
5. Check that surface of the wall is visibly saturated with water
6. If not, apply more water using spray bottle



Step 3: Wallcover Application

1. Hang XLART Wallpaper dry straight from the roll
2. Material can be re-positioned and re-aligned during first 10 minutes
3. If material doesn't move easily during repositioning, lift up material and apply more water to wall
4. Smooth the length onto the wall using your hand or a paperhanger's brush, to remove any bubbles or wrinkles
5. Trim at top and bottom, using a sharp knife, for perfect finish



Step 4: Finishing

1. Use a clean cloth or a sponge for cleaning any excess paste from XLART's Wallpaper
2. Moisten the cloth and wring out excess water. Change rinse water frequently



Step 5: Product Removal

1. When it's time for a change, product can be easily removed from the wall in one piece when mounted to surfaces as defined above
2. Note, if your wall was not well prepared, you may not achieve a one piece removal
3. Use a bucket of water and a sponge and thoroughly wet the wall mural, starting from the top
4. Keeping the mural wet, slowly peel it from the wall
5. Continue to wet down and peel off slowing any remaining adhesions
6. Wash the wall down with water to remove any remaining paste
